

Analyze Your Own Assessment

1. Analyze your test, item by item.

Identify and write down the GLE and learning target each test item assesses. Describe the learning in whatever terms you choose. If two or more items address the same learning, use the same terms to describe that learning.

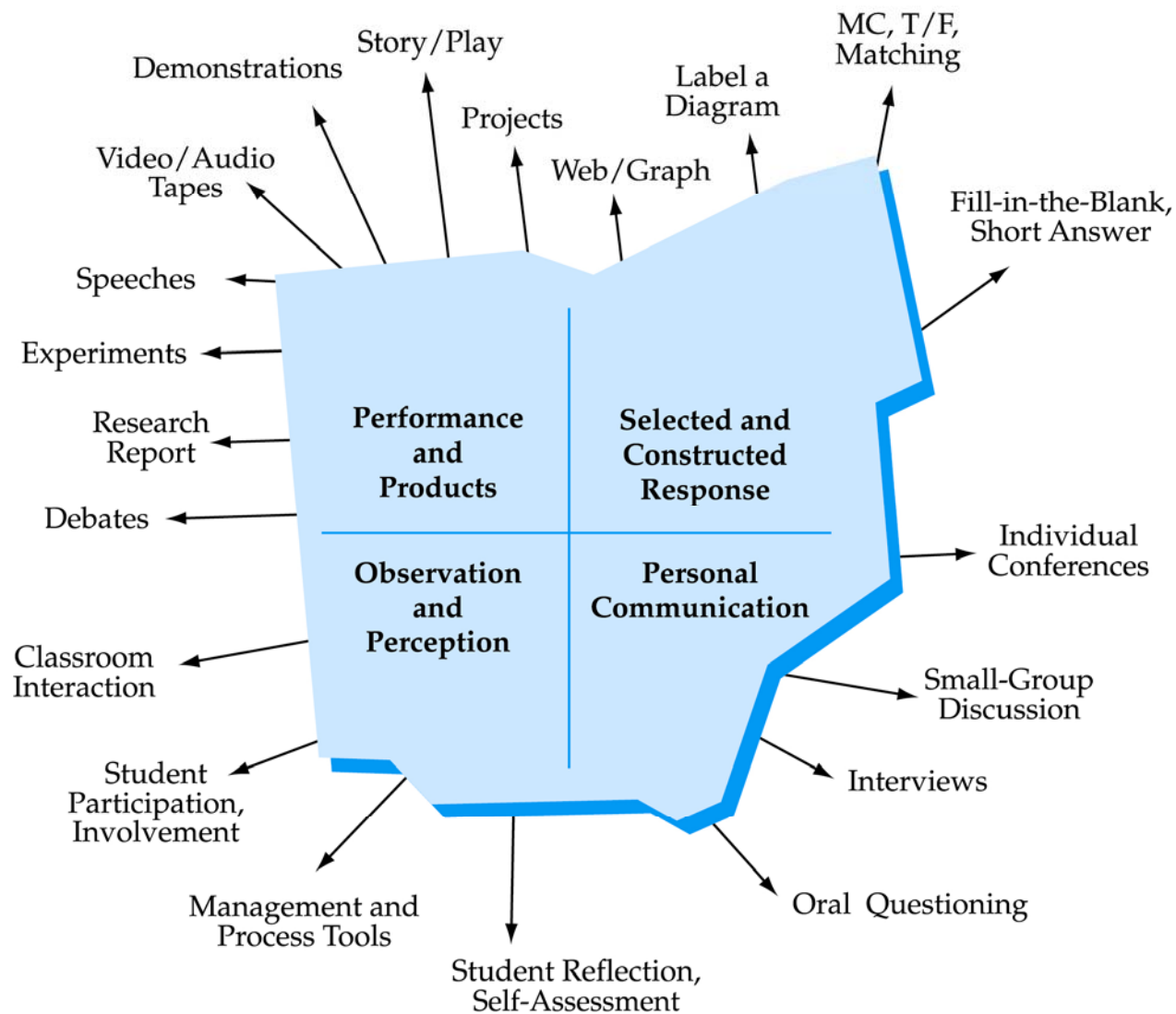
2. Organize the learning targets into a test plan framework or test blueprint.

Create a test plan framework by transferring the information from step one to a chart like the one attached. Identify the target type, assessment method and points assigned to address that GLE and learning target.

3. Analyze your test blueprint. Does your assessment represent what you taught and what you expected students to learn?
